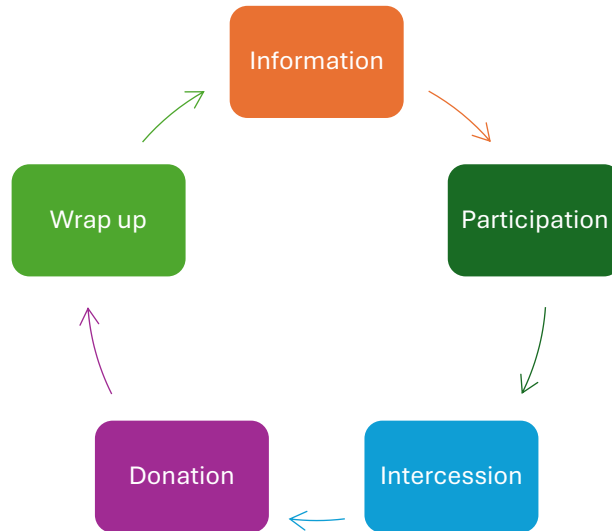


TEASA Sunday: On the Day

A guide for leaders



Information: A Powerpoint story of TEASA is part of the package, as a tool to share information about TEASA. Additionally, a one page summary of “What we do is included”. **Remember to complete the 5 points within the 10 minute time frame.**

Participation: Spell out the different ways in which Christ followers can participate in the life and work of TEASA according to their passion and calling, to strengthen evangelical impact in South Africa. These are through: TEASA commissions (Evangelism and Church Planting, Mission sending, Health Professionals, Gender Based Violence, Women’s commission, Youth Commission and Public Advocacy.

Intercession. Lead congregation to pray for TEASA and the work of Evangelical Witness in South Africa. *“My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me.”* (John 17:20-21). Especially, pray for success in **advocacy on Public policies** and **Reaching the lost in South Africa together**

Donation. Lead the congregation in a **Unity in Mission** offering
